South Bend, IN— Teachers are invited to learn about educational offerings for students at Gallery Talks for Teachers, taking place 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. on the first Thursday of each month, starting December 1. A different area of the museum will be featured monthly, with a brief talk plus a tour of a gallery. In December, the topic is Copshaholm: Community and Innovation. Teachers will be able to visit the Oliver Mansion and hear about standards-based topics and activities provided during classroom or virtual visits to the historic house.

Each Gallery Talk for Teachers will provide a certificate of completion for 1 PGP point, and teachers will receive corresponding curriculum materials. Complimentary wine will be offered.

The History Museum welcomes school visits all year long. In the past five years, over 16,500 students have toured the museum, including seven exhibit galleries, the 38-room Oliver Mansion, and Kidsfirst, an area designed for youth up to third grade.
